STRENGTHS/OPPORTUNITIES:

Easy to care, perfect for beginners

A quick-growing plant is extremely easy to care for and becomes quite lush and large

Philodendrons do not need frequent repotting

The bright green-toothed and textured foliage is an easy way to add a tropical accent to a small home or apartment
has a high resistance to pests



WEAKNESS:

Need some amount of room to spread

Leaves turn yellow when exposed to too much sunlight

Additionally, this plant may turn yellow due to too much water

Care & Handling

Longevity: 10 years plus

Water requirements: These plants like to dry slightly in between waterings, so always check the soil by sticking your finger about one inch down to ensure you're not overwatering

If the soil is moist to the touch, wait a little bit before watering again.

Light: Might do best by a window with a sheer curtain or something that's filtering the sunlight

That way, the light is not shining directly on the plant, but it is still getting a good amount of sun time

Soil/Nutrition requirements: Regular well-drained soil

Special care/remarks: Toxic to humans & pets

This is a houseplant that won't get too big but will give you a unique and medium-size plant
